This is a wonderful way to get to know more of your Probus members. Groups of 10-12 meet once a month, rotating locations thru homes of group members. The host provides the main dish and assigns/lets people choose the remainder of the dishes, which may or may not follow a theme. Members provide their own beverage of choice.

New groups will be drawn up in December to start in January. We need a few more snowbirds to sign up to make 2 groups who meet May thru October so that we can mix up the current single group. There has also been a request for a snowbody group that would meet November thru April.

When you sign up, please indicate the following: Regular (12 months, 12 people); 10 only; prefer weekends; prefer to avoid weekends; don't care; snow birds, snowbodies. You will also be asked to indicate the full months you are away to spread the absentees among the groups. If you are concerned about hosting, pick months where someone is away. You do not have to have a sit down at one table format. We do our best to mix up groups each year, but if you are concerned you may EMAIL me up to 3 pairs you feel you have been with too often or up to 3 you have not been with enough. No guarantees, but will try to match at least one of your requests. In a regular group, each couple would host twice, or each of a pair of singles would host once. Groups work with their calendars to set dates that work for their group, usually several months in advance.

Wine Appreciation for this year is coming to an end. On October 23<sup>rd</sup> we shall have our wind up meeting when the three groups come together to pick our best red and white wines for the year.

Each wine tasting group comprises of around 12 members, with a meeting each month at the home of one of the members. Either 5 whites or 5 reds are selected by the host and are rated to decide which one is best liked. The host provides simple snacks of cheese and crackers and to cover the cost of the wines, \$15 is collected from each member at the meeting. You do not have to be a wine expert to join in; you like what you like! We are careful to make the portions served relatively small. Each group includes couples and singles and the meetings are very social occasions where most of the chat is about anything other than wine.


